Dear friends,

The Easter story is the foundation upon which our faith and hope is based. Christ has died. Christ has risen. Christ will come again. These familiar words have echoed throughout the ages, affirming our belief.

Mary came to the tomb fully expecting it to be as she left it. Instead she found the stone had been rolled away, so she ran to find the disciples and tell them what had happened. *"They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him."* We don't know if Mary actually looked into the tomb. She assumed she knew what had happened by her first impressions. Many reading this story for the first time might have great difficulty believing a person could be dead and is now alive. Our job, in making disciples, is to be like "them" and help remove any stone that may block others from seeing the risen Lord.

For us it may also be the time to look honestly at a stone that may be blocking our way to complete transformation. In the life of faith we are becoming new creatures. We may find there are areas in which we do not completely trust Christ. We set up our own stones. Our stones take on many looks. They may be the stones of distrust, the pebbles of sexism, the boulders of homophobia, or the granite of selfishness. Any stone that stands in the way of making disciples for Christ or sharing God's love with others, or prevents us from living life more abundantly, needs to be rolled away.

May we, in this Easter Season, read with new eyes and hear with new ears the good news. May your stones roll away to reveal the joy anew, and may you be transformed.




