Many years ago a nurse reached out to a small child with many acts of love. The child was in an institution and considered a hopeless case. Her behavior was like that of a "wild beast." This nurse believed there was hope for this child and she felt she could communicate that hope by loving her. She visited "Little Annie" each day. Even though her presence was not acknowledged by the little girl, the nurse persisted, leaving a plate of cookies with each visit. Soon the doctors noticed a change in the little girl. She was moved out of isolation to a regular floor in the hospital. The day came when this seemingly "hopeless case" was released. "Little Annie" grew up to be Ann Sullivan, who played a crucial role in the life of Helen Keller. It was Ann who saw hope and potential in this little blind, deaf, and rebellious child. She loved her, disciplined her, played, prayed, pushed, and worked with her until Helen Keller became an inspiration to the entire world.

Love is a never-ending gift. The Apostle Paul calls love "eternal" in 1 Corinthians 13. In this story, love is passed from a nurse, to "Little Annie," and on to Helen Keller, who passed love on to many people she came in contact with throughout their lives. And each of these persons whose life was touched by Helen continue to pass of the wondrous gift to others. Yet, even before the nurse, we have to go all the way back to the beginning when God first loved His creation.

We each are touched by the love of God through many people in our lives. Join in the chain, the eternal gift of God's love. Pass love on to someone today.





