FROM THE CLERK OF SESSION: Dee Mowry

Looking back thru my 'archives', I came across the Clerk's Corner from about 10 years ago. Part of this column is, in part, a reprint from that 'column of old.'

July is the traditional month of summer in earnest!!!!! Certainly true this year. July 4 is when we celebrate the birthday of our nation (and my grandmother, Grace Mericle, our first female elder and Kathy's Mother, Eileen, my former secretary at Ohio University.) Our nation was born out of rebellion, and this word has many Biblical references. The Old Testament is replete with stories of the people of God rebelling against God and then finding themselves in intractable situations. The result was to call on God to 'bail them out'. Joshua, Chapter 22 '...in rebellion or in a breach of faith toward the Lord...' 1st Samuel Chapter 15 '...for rebellion is as the sin on divination'...1st Kings, Chapter 12, 'So Israel has been in rebellion against the House of David to this day' plus many other stories regarding rebellion.

As mentioned above, our own country was born of rebellion, not against God, but against the British Crown. It appears that the Masonic movement may have been involved in the movement, especially the incident of the famous 'Boston Tea Party'.

It is also true that about 30 of the signers of the Declaration of Independence were Presbyterians, so many so that the British referred to the movement as 'that damned Presbyterian rebellion.' On that Sunday morning, I attended the 'Old First Presbyterian Church'. In the adjoining churchyard were the burial grounds for members. Yellow ribbons were attached to the graves of the attendees of the first General Assembly 200 years ago. This was a MOST impressive sight!!!





Statue of Liberty Maze





